5. Interments for the month of March were 5 full and 3 cremains. Building improvements are almost completed, waiting on the new garage doors to complete the project. The progress report for the MWA has been submitted along with the request for reimbursement for the second hauling of fines.

Grants for the MDAQMD and BNSF have been submitted successfully and are waiting for a response. QuickBooks accounts have all been reconciled for each account and can now be used for a monthly balance sheet and to create the budget. The General Manager Ashley Tarpley has continued training by taking a CalPERS course on Payroll Reporting and Payroll Adjustments. The bid for the tree removal has been completed and sent to the MWA for approval, when the approval is given the bid will be posted publicly to continue to the next phase of landscaping.
